He married ELIZABETH LEAR Abt. 1768 in Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, daughter of JOHN LEAR and MARIA TRITSCH. She was born Abt. 1750 in Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, or possibly Maryland, and died Abt. 1820 in Adams County, Ohio.

The 1768 tax records of Air Township, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania lists Philip on the tax lists with the freeman. A freeman was a male over 21, and unmarried. In 1769 Philip appears on the regular tax list. This indicates that Philip had married Elizabeth. Elizabeth's last name could have been Lear. I have found no marriage records for Philip or Elizabeth in Pennsylvania. They could have been married in Maryland since Cumberland County was on the border with Maryland in 1768. Philip continued to appear on the tax list there until 1771. In 1771, this part of Cumberland County became part of Bedford County.

In addition to Philip, the 1768 records also list a Peter Hildebrand. I feel that Peter may have been a brother to Philip. Peter may have gone on to Lancaster County, Pennsylvania after 1768. I have not been able to locate him in Cumberland County records again.

Philip Hildebrand was living in Rostraver Township, Westmoreland County Pennsylvania in the early 1780's with his wife Elizabeth and family of about 8-10 children. In 1782 and 1783 he had 2 daughters baptized in the German Reformed Church.

Philip Hildebrand Sr. appeared in the 1790 census of Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania with a wife, 5 sons, and 5 daughters. In 1796 the Hildebrand migrated to Lewis County, Kentucky. Lewis County Ky. Records (file 1278) show that Philip and one son, David, took a lease from Thomas Forman in March 1796, and cleared 40 acres about 2 miles from Mrs. Russell's cabin on the road from Wilson's bottom to the East Fork of Cabin Creek.

The Kentucky tax records of 1800 show Philip Hildebrand Sr., Philip Jr. David, Solomon and John paid taxes in Mason County Kentucky (Lewis County did not separate from Mason County until 1806). In 1807 all of the Hildebrand except John, went to Ohio apparently to obtain land. David ended up in Clinton County Ohio; Philip Sr., Philip Jr., and Daniel (another son) were in Adams County Ohio, and Solomon settled in Pike County, Ohio.

John Hildebrand was born in 1779 in Pennsylvania and died in Lewis County Kentucky in the 1860's. John's first marriage was to Elizabeth (Betsy) Bilyeu on June 21, 1808 in Lewis County Kentucky. It was Betsy's second marriage and she probably had 3 children at the time. In 1811 their first son Abraham was born. John and Betsy probably had 4 or 5 more sons and 1 or 2 daughters between 1811 and 1821. Two of these children were Daniel (b. 1816) and Harvey (b.1820).

John Hildebrand went to Adams County Ohio in 1820 shortly after Harvey's birth (Betsy may have died at the birth of Harvey) and lived near Peebles Ohio. In this same vicinity of Ohio, Andrew Featherkile was living with his wife Nancy and their children. Sometime between 1830 and 1832 Andrew passed away. On Oct. 15, 1832 John Hildebrand and Nancy Featherkile married. By 1837 John and Nancy had moved their large combined family back to Lewis County Kentucky where they both remained until their deaths.

Abraham Hildebrand married Eliza Jane Featherkile, his stepsister (daughter of Nancy and Andrew above) on December 21, 1839 in Lewis County Kentucky. Abraham and Eliza Jane lived all their years in a cabin near the head of Sycamore Creek. Children of this couple were SARAH (b. 1840) m. Stephen Hicks), JOHN (b.1841, d. 1861, Civil War, Gerard County Ky.), ELIZABETH (b. 1845, d. young), GEORGE (b.1847), WILLIAM (b.1849), HARVEY (b.1854) PERRY (b. 1861 m. Adelaide Kerr) and DANIEL (b. 1869, d. 1934, Lajunta, Colorado) Eliza Jane died about 1881. Abraham Hildebrand married Catharine Sutton in 1884 (no children) and died in 1886.

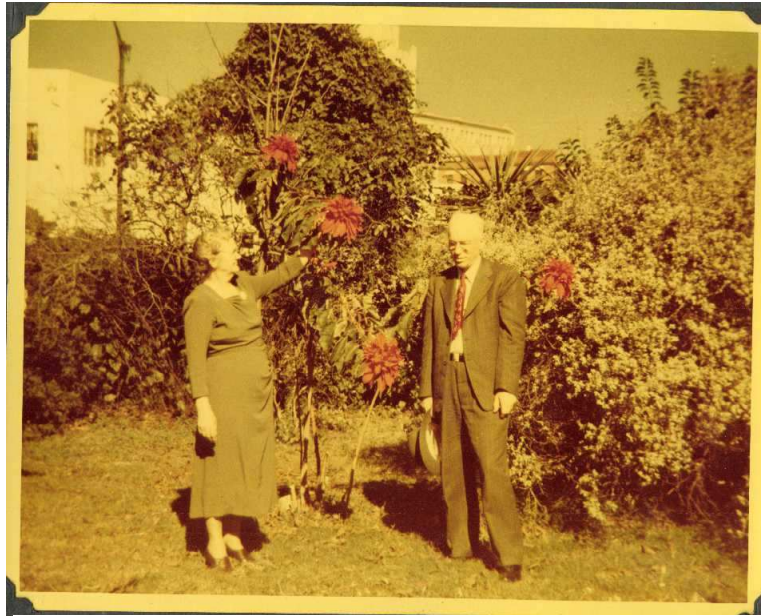

Nellie Moore-Helterbran changed the spelling of their last name to Hildebrandt after she had her children. She legally changed it in 1971 and it became Hildebrandt. She changed her three children's birth certificates at that time, as well. I have a copy of the legal document to prove this.

William (Bill) was in the Nursing Home in Williamsburg, Clermont County, Ohio (located near the corner of St. Rt. 133 and E. Main St.) for two years before he died. He would run away and start walking down Main Street, and by the time they could catch him he would be to the bridge in town (Williamsburg), which was probably $\frac{1}{4}$ mile away from the nursing home. He said he had to go see his wife because she was sick.

Nellie's death certificate says her father's name is Absolan Moore, and her mother's name is (Arizona) Ella Bonham, but other records/documents, and from talking to people, their names were stated as Absolom Moore and Arizona Bonham.

Notes from me Alfreda Lynn (Potrafke) Hildebrandt (written 2002):

I remember Grandma Nelle very well. She was always good to me and my kids. She made each of my children hand-made quilts when she was in her mid to late 90's. She was in very good health, except she didn't hear well. I remember, she would come to my kids' birthday parties and her and my granny would sit on the couch together and laugh a while, then both of them would fall asleep! I have lots of good memories of her; and my kids remember her, too.

Aunt Bernice (Grandma Nelle's daughter) was always nice too, although we didn't see her very often, as she lived in Dallas, Texas. When Grandma Nelle was alive, every year she would go to Texas and stay the winter with Aunt Bernice and her family, then come back here in the summer and stay at May McQuary's. Aunt Bernice would drive half-way, and Phil & Eva would drive half way, they met in Tennessee every year to get Grandma Nelle back and forth; until one year, when they decided she should fly! Grandma Nelle wasn't very happy about that, but they finally got her on a plane for the first time ever when she was 95 years old. The Flight Attendants and all the people on the plane gave her extra special attention and care, as this was her first flight, and she was alive and remembered the first airplane being flown! They gave her a pin with wings on it. She flew to Texas for a few more years; then she stayed in Williamsburg Ohio all year round because of her health and age.

We (the family) gave her a 100th birthday party at the Presbyterian Church in Williamsburg, Clermont County, Ohio, and she was still getting around just fine! She was a lot of fun!

She and Bill (her husband) lived on Lytle Avenue in Williamsburg Ohio when they moved from Hillsboro, Highland County, Ohio. After Grandma Nelle got older, she moved in with a lady who took care of older people in her home, her name was May McQuary. Grandma Nelle lived with her until she died.

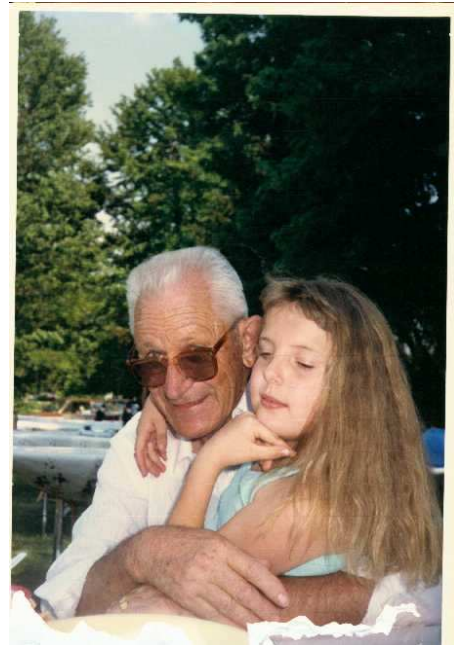

Phil was born on Johnson Street in Hillsboro, Highland County, Ohio. Their house had a big front porch with a railing all the way around it. In the back of the house, upstairs, there was a large sleeping room all of the family slept there in the summers, where it was cooler. They lived there until 1931, when Bill (William Adam), Phil's dad, got a job at the Chair Factory in Williamsburg, which was when they moved to Lytle Avenue in Williamsburg, Clermont County, Ohio.



Phil went to elementary school in Hillsboro, Highland County, Ohio until 1931. He went to high school in Williamsburg, Clermont County, Ohio for three years; and did not graduate. He was playing around with Helen Potrafke (a friend) in school one day and pushed her. He was just acting silly; but the principal saw him push her and smacked him across the face. He smacked him so hard that Phil had this man's hand print on his face the rest of that day. Phil left school that day and never went back. That was just three weeks before his graduation.

Phil lived in Williamsburg Ohio until he married Eva in 1941. (see marriage notes for the rest of this story, about the places Phil lived.)

Phil was in the United States Army Air Force for four years. He worked at Drackett's where they made foods from soy beans, then he worked at Swallen's Department Stores, as an Appliance Repairman for sixteen years until he retired.

Notes from Alfreda (Potrafke) Hildebrandt (written 2002):

Phil was the best father-in-law to me, and the best grandpa to my kids that I could have ever hoped for. I miss him so much.

Nellie Moore-Hilderbrand (Phil's mom) changed their last name to Hildebrandt after she had her children. She legally changed it in 1971 and it became Hildebrandt. She changed her three children's birth certificates, too, at that time. I don't have Lloyd's birth certificate yet, but Phil's last name is spelled Helterbran on his birth certificate, and Berneice's is spelled Hilterbrant.

He was an absolutely wonderful person. I have ALL good memories of him. He was always there for me, no matter what I needed. And he was there for my kids, as well. He babysat, got them after school when I was working, went to get them if they got sick at school and I was at work, just always there when we needed or wanted him for ANYTHING. He always took the best care of the kids, they had so much fun with him. They both remember and miss him very much. He played games with them, took them to the park and other places, and loved them more than anything, and was a very good Grandpa to them.

Phil was ALWAYS full of fun and acting silly! He and my dad would come over to our house and get our kids and our dog, Wally all wound up! They loved it! Phil and my dad were good buddies and we always had lots of fun at holidays, birthday parties, etc., because they were both crazy!

Phil also loved my granny; he loved to pick on her! She always laughed when she was around him, and I always thought that was such a good thing.

The first house Dale and I bought, Phil found for us. It was just around the corner from him and Eva. The house was much smaller than theirs and he had hoped that one day after he retired that we would buy their house and they would buy ours. Unfortunately, it didn't happen while he was alive. Soon after he died, we switched houses with Eva because she was all alone in their large house, and we thought since Phil was no longer there, she probably needed a change. She was having a very difficult time dealing with his death. She had lived in that same house with him for over 40 years. I just couldn't imagine how she felt in their big house all alone. I never felt quite right in that house without Phil there, either.

Another silly memory, but quite a big deal to me was that since Phil lived just around the corner from us, and I am terrified of spiders, I could always call him and he would come right over and kill a spider for me if Dale wasn't home!

I have so many good memories of Phil, I can't even begin to write them. I always knew he loved me as if I were his own daughter. He took me to the doctor when I was sick, he helped me with my kids, and was so good to all of us. I really miss him.

Phil's death has been one of the hardest things I have ever had to go through in my life. Even after so many years, I still miss him as though he was here yesterday. He is most definitely one of the most important people in my life and will remain that way forever.

My daughter, Dusti was also very close to Phil; he spoiled her rotten! Phil had four sons and no daughters, and two other grand-daughters besides Dusti, whom he didn't get to see as often as he saw Dusti, since we lived so close. Phil and Dusti were buddies from the day she was born! He would take her every chance he'd get. He and Eva would take Dusti and Adam on picnics to the lake, to the playground, for walks, and many other things. They got to do so many fun things with them. Both kids still talk about him and all the fun things they did with him. They really miss him, too.

Notes from Eva (Gabbard) Hildebrandt (notes taken between 2000 – 2003):
(these notes were a little difficult to translate from the way Eva told the stories)



Eva was born in Vincent, Owsley County, Kentucky (up the road from the school, as she said it). Her dad died before she was born. Her mom re-married Chester Goocey and they moved to the house where Chester and his first wife (his first wife had died) and son lived, in Old Orchard, Lee County, Kentucky. They eventually moved back to Vincent. Then, when Dot (Eva's half-sister) was a baby (8 months old), Mattie (Eva's mom) put Dot on their cow and Eva walked beside them, and they moved to a house "across the hill" (as Eva said it) in Vincent, Kentucky. Eva's Mammie (her grandmother) and Grandpa Hall lived with them there. Mammie Hall lived there until she died. When Mattie was pregnant with her last child, Norma (who was a

twin, and her twin died soon after birth), she asked her mother (Mammie) if she would keep her children together as long as possible, because she knew she was going to die from the birth of the twins. Fortunately, Mattie's mother kept the five girls together until she died. Mammie and Mattie's five daughters lived in the house "over the hill" until she died. After Mammie died, Eva visited (lived with) Uncle Charlie and Aunt Viney in Cincinnati, Ohio (Mt. Adams). After being with her Uncle Charlie & Aunt Viney a while, Eva visited (lived with) Aunt Mary Catron, near Fayetteville, Brown County, Ohio on Route 50. Next, she moved on to Uncle John Moore's, where he and his son lived. Eva had to skip two years of school, when she was 14 and 15 years old because they had no money for board and no way to get to school. She graduated when she was 20 years old.

When Eva was 15, they moved in with Uncle Arch, where they called "on the boardwalk", in Hazard, Owsley County, Kentucky. She played the clarinet as a teenager, in school. Next, Eva moved with Uncle Arch to 313 Cedar Street in Hazard, Kentucky. She then moved with Uncle John and Aunt Sarah to Bantam, on St. Rt. 125, near Bethel in Clermont County Ohio.

Uncle John took Eva, Mavis & Norma to Bethel to get a job. They got jobs at the P. Sullivan Shoe Factory for 40 cents an hour. The three of them got a one room apartment in Bethel at Geeslan's, in town. That is where Eva got the pretty rocking chair she had in her living room forever, that two of her daughter-in-laws would love to have! It's been a little joke between us, as we love this old chair! Mavis had washed clothes and laid wet socks on the chair to dry and ruined it, so the landlord sold it to them when they moved from there for \$1.00.

From Geeslan's, they moved to Charity Street, still in Bethel Ohio and now they had two furnished rooms, on the backside of a big house. Next Eva, Mavis, & Norma moved to a little house (that had been made from a chicken house) that Ruth and Bob Hannah owned. It was located off St. Rt. 133, where there is a fork in the road just north of Bethel. Eva worked for the Hannah's; took care of their kids and house, and cooked for them. She met Phil while she lived there and lived there until she and Phil got married. (see marriage notes for the rest of this story, about the places Eva lived.)

After Phil and Eva were married, she worked at Sears, then she worked in a drug store in Boise Idaho for a few months. She also worked as a waitress at the Coffee Cup restaurant in Williamsburg, Ohio. After those jobs, she was a cook at the Williamsburg Elementary and High Schools. She worked for the Williamsburg Schools until she was 64, when she retired, but remained on call as a cook there until she was 70 years old.

Eva birthed babies in just a few hours. Medication made her sleep for a day or two with the first three, but with Dale, she didn't get medication and got to see his birth. She seemed so excited while talking about this!

Notes from Alfreda L. Potrafke (written 2008):

Eva, same as Phil, was the best mother-in-law to me and grandma to my kids that I could have ever hoped for.

Eva was like a mother to me. She was always there when I needed her, and always helped me with problems and things throughout my life. She taught me so many things, from cleaning, crocheting, knitting, sewing, cooking, to being a mom and a wife! It's endless, the things she taught me throughout the years.

She was always there for my kids, too. She was a very special grandma. She was always there to baby sit when I needed her, and did so many fun things with my kids.

Eva was friends with my granny. They both were such an inspiration. It's hard to imagine where I would be today if Eva had not been a part of my life. I could always depend on her. She definitely made a difference in my life. I love her dearly and always will. I miss living around the corner from her; as I have no one to run to any more!

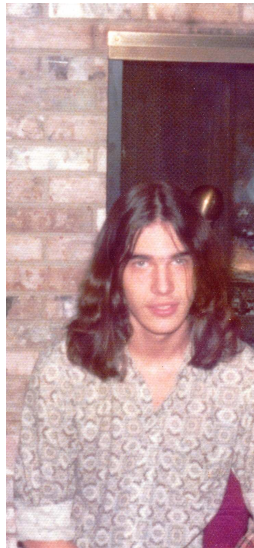
